For individual student fundraisers, students must be given the opportunity to directly pay the costs that are assessed to them instead of fundraising. Students may not be assessed fees in excess of the Board approved fee schedule. The parents/guardians of elementary students must give permission for their students to participate. Raffles are illegal in Utah and are, therefore, prohibited as a fundraising effort. Door-to-door sales are prohibited. Potential risk concerns, including student safety, transportation issues, and appropriate supervision.
