Review Last Meeting's Minutes: Title 1 and Trustlands Plans will remain the same as 2018-2019; robotics after school club is currently happening; choir – Laurie Miller is no longer available to be the director, any other parents interested in directing?, possibly have as an after-school club and teacher(s) direct, Shannon will follow up with principal and teachers, Sarah Judd will follow up with PTA

Title 1 Plan: Reviewed Math, Reading, and 'Most At-Risk Students' goals. USBE has reviewed and evaluated the data from RISE and is recommending that the State School Board approve it as 'official data'. If approved, we should receive our data sometime in October. From preliminary results, Westside seems to have improved in ALL subjects: reading, math, and science. We were praised and reprimanded on our ELL students; praise – they made more progress than any other group of students in the school; reprimand – they are still our lowest and 'most at-risk students'

TSSA Plan: As directed by the state, we will no longer have a yearly 'Schoolwide Plan'. Instead we will have a 'Teacher & Student Success Act Plan'. This plan corresponds to additional funds being provided to the school. Since this is the first year we are still learning what the plan will include.

Additional Comments/Questions: *Does Westside currently teach any coding?* Not that we are aware of. Mrs. Arroyo will follow up with Mrs. Paulsen about possibly teaching some coding in computers and with Mrs. Hjorth about possibly having a coding after-school club/class. Mrs. Boucher & Mrs. Hammer will email Mrs. Arroyo names of outside businesses who offer coding classes for schools.
