**Additional Questions/Concerns**

Mr. Lovell – asked parents about feelings on parent communication; parents said that there is NEVER too much and that consistency in when and how teachers communicate to parents is important;

Parents – issues with Infinite Campus; the program works well for checking grades, but it is difficult to know who emails are coming from and which student the email is about; maybe if teachers could put their name and the student's name in the subject line it would be helpful to parents

Ms. Nielsen – asked for feedback about SEP's; parents like having options (Zoom, email, in-person) and like being given those options each time because student needs might change; discussed possibly doing ~~Walking Report Cards~~ Student Led Conferences in the spring for SEP's; no centers, just have each student work at their own desk; Mr. Lovell shared an idea he used last year; each student creates a PowerPoint presentation that covers each area for Student Led Conferences with links, videos, etc.; the PowerPoint could be shared with parents in the classroom or via email for those parents who would prefer not to come school for SEP's;
