2021-2022 Trustlands Plan

Literacy Goal: By the end of the 2021-2022 school year, the percent of students in grades K-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress in reading will increase by 1%.

2021-2022 Title 1 Plan

Literacy Goal: In the areas of literacy on the RISE test, Westside Elementary students will score within 4% of district results for the 2021-2022 school year.

Data Review – Acadience MOY Data

From the beginning of the year to the middle of the year, district wide every grade saw the number of kids proficient stay the same or improve!

From the beginning of the year to the middle of the year at Westside, the number of kids proficient:

- K - increased by 2%
- 1 - decreased by 3%
- 2 - increased by 3%
- 3 - stayed the same
- 4 - decreased by 7%
- 5 - increased by 13%

Compared to scores from the middle of the year last year, this year district wide every grade saw an increase in proficiency.

Compared to scores from the middle of the year last year, this year at Westside

- K - increased by 7%
- 1 - decreased by 2%
- 2 - increased by 9%
- 3 - decreased by 17%

Based on this data, our SCC decided to not make any changes to our Trustlands Plan or Title 1 Plan.
