School LAND Trust Plan

Title 1 Plan – Data Discussion/Comprehensive Needs Assessment

- 1) Language Arts Student Proficiency
 - a) As a school, we did not meet the literacy goal for the 2021-2022 school year
 - i) In the area of literacy on the RISE test, Westside Elementary students will score within 4% of district results for the 2021-2022 school year.
 - ii) Westside – 36% proficiency
 - iii) Nebo – 41% proficiency
 - iv) Difference – Westside was 5% lower than the district
 - b) Female students scored higher (48.4% proficient) than male students (27.3 % proficient)
 - c) Limited English Proficiency students still struggling (5.7% proficient); classroom teachers set goals for them;
- 2) Mathematics Student Proficiency
 - a) As a school, we DID meet the math goal for the 2021-2022 school year
 - i) In the area of math on the RISE test, Westside Elementary students will score within 6% of district results for the 2021-2022 school year.
 - ii) Westside – 33% proficiency
 - iii) Nebo – 39 % proficiency
 - iv) Difference – Westside was 6% lower than the district
 - b) Male students scored higher than female students
 - c) Limited English Proficiency students still struggling; classroom teachers set goals for them;
- 3) Science Student Proficiency
 - a) As a school, we do not have a science goal
 - b) Female students scored higher (36.4% proficient) than male students (25.4 % proficient)
- 4) Limited English Proficiency students did better in science than LA & Math (15.8% proficient);
- 5) Questions
 - a) Council members would like to see data comparing Westside to other Title 1 schools in Nebo District
 - b) Shannon will bring that data next month
