WHAT IS TITLE 1?



- A federal allocation of funds for schools classified as low income for the purpose of assisting students to demonstrate proficiency related to the state's academic standards.
- ☐ Title I is a **federally funded program** under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA).
- Title I, Part A provides Utah approximately \$86 million each year to help higher poverty schools provide **supplemental educational services** to meet the needs of educationally disadvantaged students.

HOW DOES WESTSIDE PARTICIPATE IN TITLE 1?

- 1. Create a school-wide plan for student growth.
- 2. Hire and train paraprofessional.
- 3. Support students that are at risk with targeted

interventions.

- 4. Family Engagement.
- 5. Purchase supplies.

Westside parents help the school administration develop a Parent Engagement Policy each year


Westside parents, teachers, and administration develop and abide by a Student-Family-School Compact
